



Chrome (142+) and Edge (143+) SigWeb Settings

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Instructions

Permission Request From Browser

With the new browser versions, a Local Network Access (LNA) prompt may be displayed. Select "Allow" to confirm the use of SigWeb on that webpage. Alternatively, one of the methods described below may be used:

Granting Local Network Access

- In Chrome, navigate to: `chrome://settings/content/localNetworkAccess`
- In Edge, navigate to: `edge://settings/privacy/sitePermissions/allPermissions/localNetworkAccess`

Under "Allowed to connect to any device on your local network", click "Add". Enter the website URL and confirm by clicking "Add".

Temporary Workaround

- For Chrome, go to: `chrome://flags/#local-network-access-check`
- For Edge, go to: `edge://flags/#local-network-access-check`

Open the Chrome or Edge browser. Under "Local Network Access Checks", change setting to "Disabled". Then, restart your browser.
